Prayer points for the Nigeria ACU (Africa Christian University) Project:

I am sometimes asked why I minister in Nigeria. My answer: I believe God has me serving in Nigeria, working on a project to build leaders that "stand firm for a lifetime", so that God can use them to deliver His people. I believe:

- God is answering the prayers of his people in Nigeria, the cries of his people and
- God wants the Western church to share our spiritual and financial blessings, to help disciple the rapidly growing mature and help meet the needs of the least of these.

A few facts about Nigeria and Christians in Nigeria:

- Nigeria the most populous nation in Africa.
- The church continues growing rapidly and is estimated to double in size by 2060
- The Church faces many challenges in Nigeria:
 - <u>The Poor</u>: The National Bureau of Statistics (NBS), reports that 40 percent of people (83 million) live below the poverty line of \$380 a year, more than any other country in the world.
 - <u>Terrorism</u> against Christians have resulted in over 11,500 Christians have being murdered since June 2015. Four to five million Christians are displaced. 2000 churches have been destroyed.
 - <u>Corruption</u>: Nigeria is assessed to be one of the most corrupt nations in the world.

Please pray for Nigeria:

- For the government leaders, that Christians would pursue politics and be salt and light. For peace in the land.
- That the global church would minister to the least of these, to the poor.

Pray for the racial tensions – particularly as it relates to the Fulani herdsman.

- Jihadist Fulani militias are now considered the world's deadliest terror group. As with other race-based issues around the world, many blame ALL the Fulani herdsman for the deadly actions of a few.
- Pray that the church promotes peace and stand against racism, particularly racism against the Fulani.

Please pray for Imala:

- For Kabiyesi (the king, photo below). For wisdom, continue leading with the salt and light of Christ.
- For our ministry to the least of these:
 - the poor in Imala (picture of Imala below); for funding for our Feed Nigeria program.
 - Programs to help the Fulani herdsmen in Imala land.
 - Our projects in Imala. Particularly for funding for our dormitory project.
