Thank you for your prayers, and particularly for those prayed for a strong finish to my extended time in Nigeria and my recent safe return.

<u>Providence International University</u>: I am pleased to report that the university project reached a major milestone, with an inaugural board meeting of Providence International University Board. The meeting was chaired by Elder Felix Ohiwerei and was attended by several who have played key roles in progressing the project for many years, including Prof. Gary S. Maxey, Dr Victoria Ezeokoli, Dr Ife Sofola and myself. We were joined by Archbishop Michael Stephen, Dr. Peter Ozodo, Dr. Sam Buti Kputu, Architect John-Bede Anthonio and Pastor Segun Adegbiji. Please pray for the board as we map the way forward. Please pray for additional board members and advisors.

<u>Projects:</u> The pictures below show two ongoing projects. First, <u>the Solid Rock Prayer Center</u>. The insert shows the completed prayer room; the room has been commissioned and is currently being used as part of CDF's prayer ministry and the Solid Rock Camp. The completion of the rest of the building is currently suspended pending additional funding. Second, our <u>twin research center greenhouse</u> (shown on the right). The new facility will allow us to expand our agricultural research application programs, a steppingstone to the college of agriculture.



<u>Agriculture:</u> We are also concluding the early harvest season. The picture below shows some of our cassava and corn harvest. We are currently replanting; we are also planning a major cropping expansion project, including irrigation along the dam. Shown below is a team assessing the planned site for an irrigation dam we plan to present to partners.
