God continues to help build the foundation of the project. We continue to learn to trust in Him and His provision and live holy lives for Him as the Project progresses. In 2024, we focused on 1) PIU program and fund development (via three part-time staff), 2) continued with land pursuit, registration, and possession (picture right shows signing of one of two strategic tracts), and 3) development of strategic approaches to partnering with like-minded Christians, churches, and institutions. Some key activities are highlighted below: 1) kick off a Youth Development Thinktank, 2) signing an MOU with the Holy Spirit Mission Church to pilot testing extension site youth development programs, 3) partnering discussion with African Gospel Church



in Kenya, 4) development of awareness program designed to help win the battle of world views (program at WATS).

We continue helping the least of these, providing food and health programs. This year we increased feeding of the elderly and poor; the smiles of gratitude are a real joy. (Staff volunteers shown to the right)



Progress continues on the Prayer and Mission Center at Solid Rock in Texas. Now, in addition to a prayer room and office, we have a counseling room

and a larger prayer room. In January we hosted Kabiyesi (King of Imala) and his wife. We all joined in prayer with longtime prayer partners Betty Hughes, and Price and Betty Rose (they have been praying for CDF since 2000!)
