We were also introduced to Dr Sunday, an expert with experience in establishing a Faculty of Education. Dr Sunday is committed to working with us, specifically with Dr Tade and staff.





I thank God for Denise, one of my Eccelsiastes three fold-cords! We were able to build on our bond during our time in Nigeria and during our trip to Spain (our first vacation in 5 years, and then spending time with our grand daughter, Grace, and missionary friend of over 40 years, Jack.

Victorious Service

A key theme for our trip was reminding our staff of the spiritual battle that comes with serving in Kingdom Work. I encouraged each of them to have 12 friends praying for them and their role in the project. We also continue our monthly prayer gatherings on the 20th (see photo showing Denise praying with one of the Imala groups). We encourage staff to be intentional in developing three-fold cord bonds with at least three pentors (peer-mentors), friends that help us through the storms.
